## LiveUp Podcast Participation Agreement

This agreement outlines the expectations and guidelines for participating in The LiveUp Podcast with Dr. Roy Smith. By joining as a caller/guest, you agree to the following terms.

### Podcast Overview:

Hosted by Dr. Roy Smith, the founder of Pennsylvania Counseling Services, Servant's Oasis, and LiveUp Resources, the podcast draws on his 40+ years of experience to discuss topics of personal and professional growth, leaving participants feeling more competent to tackle life's issues that come their way.

### Recording and Distribution Rights:

- **Consent to Record:** By participating in the podcast, participants consent to being recorded. The podcast host has the right to edit, distribute, and use the recording across various platforms.

  - Language that may be triggering to other participants.
  - Discussions that are inauthentic, off topic, or overly confusing.
  - Statements that could compromise the confidentiality of another.
- **Non-Solicitation:** Participants are prohibited from using the podcast to solicit business or promote personal services without prior approval.

### **Technical Requirements:**

**Technical Readiness:** The LiveUp Podcast will take place via Zoom. Participants should ensure access to a stable internet connection, appropriate equipment (e.g., microphone, headphones), and an appropriate environment with minimized noise or distraction to maintain the quality of the recording.

### **Right to Decline Participation:**

- **Host Discretion:** The podcast host reserves the right to decline participation to anyone who does not adhere to these guidelines or whose participation may not align with the goals of the podcast.
